

## Results Overview 2017-18

The school enjoyed yet another school-best set of results at both GCSE and sixth form in 2017. Progress 8, the new headline measure of school performance, rose from +0.24 in 2016 to +0.49 in 2017. This represents a move in to the **top 5% of schools nationally** from a position in the top 25% in 2016. Improvement was found across all four component areas of the measure as shown in the table below:

For the third year in succession, sixth form results were the best in the school's history. A level results rose again to secure a value added score of +0.04. Meanwhile we maintained our position amongst the very best institutions nationally in Applied General (Vocational) courses, with another best ever school score of +1.04. Outstanding results were found right across the range of other courses in sixth form, with both GCSE English and GCSE Maths resit classes registering value added scores of +0.44 and +0.43, respectively.
