Dear Parents/Carers,

You will be aware that the Prime Minister has announced that a national lockdown commenced today and will continue for at least the first half of the Spring term. Therefore; school is now closed to the vast majority of pupils; however, children of key workers and vulnerable children will be able to attend school.

If you are a key worker and want your child to attend school please notify the school by going onto the website link <http://www.carltonbolling.co.uk/keyworkersurvey/>.

Students in years 10 and 11 will have “live” on line lessons from Tuesday 5th January 2021. Please ensure that your child logs on punctually for their lessons, which will follow their usual timetable. They will need to log on via their google classroom.

Discussions between the government, examination boards and Ofqual are taking place regarding examinations this summer. Year 11 students will have some exams this year and once we are informed of when these will be taking place we will share the information with you. It is essential that Year 10 and 11 students complete all the work they are set and if they have any questions regarding their learning they let their teachers know.

All other students in years 7,8 and 9 will continue to learn at home using on line learning via their google classroom. This will start on Monday 11th January and further information will be sent to families at the end of this week explaining what timetable the students will be following. Information regarding logging on to Google classrooms, how to upload work and complete assignments will all be included.

We have a limited number of digital devices you can borrow if your child does not have access to a laptop, computer or tablet at home. If you would like to borrow a device for the time your child is not in school, contact school on 01274 633111 and speak to Ms Whittaker. As the parent/carer you will need to collect a device from reception agreeing to our terms and conditions for the loan. Once back in school your child will need to return the device.

Whilst we await further information from the government; if your child is entitled to a free school meal and is working from home; a grab bag meal will be available to be picked up from school. Please telephone school reception 01274 633111 by 10:00am to order your meal. Collection will be between 12:00 and 12:30 each day.
