**End of Year examinations:**

All students will be sitting end of term exams in all their subjects during the dates listed below. Students will be given support and resources to ensure they prepare well for their exams.

Years 7, 8 and 9: 17<sup>th</sup> June 2019 until 28<sup>th</sup> June 2019  
Year 10 Mock examinations: 24<sup>th</sup> June 2019 until 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2019.

Other key activities in this final half term:

3<sup>rd</sup> July 2019: Year 6 transition when we will welcome our new year 7s.  
17<sup>th</sup> July 2019: Year 8 KS3 Graduation.

We insist our students are dressed appropriately and present themselves in school appropriately and in a professional manner. Please can I remind parents about the school's expectations regarding uniform and the general appearance of students.

- Full uniform is expected, including tie, coloured lanyard and student ID card (replacement ID cards cost £3.50 from student reception). Trainers and canvas pumps are not permitted (full details are available on the school website)
- Additional jewellery is not permitted. Students are allowed to wear ONE pair of stud-type earrings and a watch. Other items will be confiscated and returned to parents on Friday after 1.00 pm
- False nails are not permitted for health and safety reasons
- Extreme make-up, false eyelashes and cosmetic contact lenses are not permitted
- 'Extreme' haircuts are not permitted. This includes the application of 'unnatural' colours and patterns/motifs etched into the hairstyle as well as patterns shaved into eyebrows.

School closes for the summer holiday on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2019 and reopens on Thursday September 5<sup>th</sup> 2019 for the next academic year. Students are expected to be in school for 8.20am ready to start their lessons.
